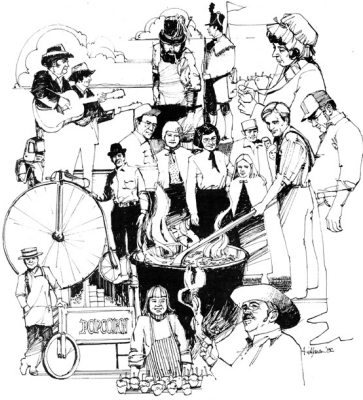

### Guidelines for the Living History Area

- Pre-1865 attire must be worn at all times during the event.
- Tents must be pre-1865 in design.
- No modern items should be visible.
- Reasonable safety for you and the public must be observed at all times.
- **All fires must be in structures provided; please adapt your fire cooking procedures**
- All unused firewood is to be returned where you found it.
- Each camp must have a fire bucket if a fire is used.
- All loose straw should be raked in pile for easy clean-up. Unbroken bales should be stacked to front of your campsite.
- **PARKING: THERE IS NO PARKING ON THE GRASS IN THE BLUE BELL PARK AREA ON SATURDAY PER THE VILLAGE OF GRAND RAPIDS. SO WHEN UNLOADING PLEASE PARK ON PAVEMENT ONLY. IN ADDITION, VEHICLES MUST TO BE MOVED AS SOON AS THEY ARE EMPTY TO MAKE ROOM FOR OTHERS COMING IN.**
- Parking will be at the Mary Jane Thurston State Dam Lot (3 blocks west of town). They have agreed to allow us to begin parking there on Friday. **YOU MUST PARK IN THE EAST END OF THE LOT FIRST.** That's the end closest to town. Parking passes **MUST** be hanging from your rear view mirror. Please back into the parking space. Vehicles with trailers please back your trailers onto the grass.
- Set-ups are Friday and Saturday

#### **No breakdown before 5:00 pm on Sunday.**

- All items for sale or on display must be pre-1865 in nature. No rubber or plastic bags, tarps, tarp straps, bungee cords or PVC is permitted. Plexiglass is permitted on display cases.
- No unauthorized vehicles are permitted on the levee.
- No mass produced or contemporary wares to be sold without our approval.

***WE ARE GUESTS ON THE LEVEE – PLEASE LEAVE YOUR AREA CLEAN AND YOUR FIRE STRUCTURES IN FRONT OF YOUR SITE!***
