Non-Profit Food Booths - Rules and Regulations Festival Date: Sunday, October 13, 2024

Dear Friends,

We are very excited for this year's festival and it would not be the same without you! We are also proud to invite your non-profit organization to participate in this year's festival. Enclosed you will find an application to be filled out and returned by **September 1.** The food booth fee is **\$200 per parking space**.

FOOD BOOTH GUIDELINES:

- **ALL BOOTHS MUST BE DECORATED.** Do your best to make the theme of booths and volunteers match the fest. Suggestions: Straw bales, corn stalks, scarecrows, pumpkins, mums and other fall decorations.
- As a non-profit organization with less than 6 retail days per year, you are tax exempt. As a for-profit organization with more than 6 retail days per year, you're required to have a temporary vendor's permit and collect/report sales tax.
- You must have your temporary health/food permits at least 10 days in advance - Permits will not be issued on Fest day.
- A Certificate of Insurance from your insurance agency is required. Please return this to me prior to **9/15.**
- THROUGHOUT THE DAY, PLEASE DISPOSE OF WASTE IN PROVIDED DUMPSTERS
